

Ministry FAQ

You rarely find a competent and effective husband and wife team working in deliverance. Before contacting me I highly recommend that you explore their services as they are better able to provide a full and hands-on experience to you. Also, if you are female, you will need some place with female ministers and if you are a couple you will need services for a couple. God bless you and lead you to the freedom you deserve through Jesus Christ.

I have modified the text as it pertains to the Be Healed Now ministry.

Is there a cost involved for deliverance sessions?

Yes and no. There are always costs involved in a ministry just like there are costs incurred in running a secular business. At this time I do not charge for deliverance sessions and that is my choice. I ask every candidate to consider donating to the ministry as he is led by Holy Spirit to do so. Please do not let your inability to donate stop you from coming for deliverance.

How long is a session?

Sessions are usually one to two hours depending on the situation. There are a total of 5 sessions.

Where are deliverance sessions conducted? Sessions are conducted in my office in Gulfport, MS.

Can I bring someone with me for my session?

I do not allow anyone else other than possible team members and trainees to take part in a deliverance session. Many times, things are revealed in a deliverance session that need to be kept private. It is also possible that husbands or wives that have not been through deliverance begin to become a distraction because they have not been set free. A person's session should be between them and the Lord without outside distractions.

How do I set up a deliverance session?

Currently (due to lack of female ministers) my ministry is exclusive to male candidates only. You can use the contact information on my Website, BeHealedNow.com, to reach out to me. I will answer your email or recorded message. If you are female and/or seeking deliverance ministry as a couple I suggest you contact either [Finding Freedom Ministries](#) in Virginia or [Above and Beyond Christian Academy](#). Both are highly recommended.

Once we connect and agree on a day and time for our first session, go onto our Website, download, and print the Confidential Candidate In-Take Form. Read the form and complete it and email it or bring it to our scheduled session. If for some reason you cannot complete the form ahead of our session you can complete the form at my office but it will extend the time of our first session. When are deliverance sessions conducted?

I strive to schedule deliverance sessions during the day on Weekdays, however; they may also

be scheduled at night or on the Weekends.

Can anyone go through a deliverance session?

Most deliverance ministries will not work with someone who is not a Christian or who has no church/Christian fellowship support. I will agree to meet with any men for the first session even though they have not committed themselves to Christ. However, the following sessions will not be scheduled unless you come to agreement and are persuaded to become a Christian. At that point I can proceed. This is because lasting deliverance is not available to those who have not accepted Christ as their Savior.

To get free from demonic oppression it is necessary to be living with Christ as the Lord of your life. Full deliverance sessions are reserved for believers that want to be completely free from all oppression. It requires a dedicated relationship with Christ and “clean” living to stay free, otherwise; their oppression will quickly return.

Can deliverance fix your marriage, your addiction, your relationship with God?

Yes and No. Deliverance and healing can strengthen your relationship with Christ, but it is your relationship with Christ that will fix your marriage, your addiction, and your problems.

Here is what one respected deliverance ministry says:

“You may need to go through sozo, inner healing, or counseling to make sure that all issues with unforgiveness, bitterness, anger, resentment, disappointment, or addiction are resolved before coming to a deliverance session. I have partnered with others offering these services, and I can refer a candidate according to their needs. I have found that many amazing inner healing programs are “light” on deliverance, and many deliverance ministries are “light” on inner healing. It is difficult to be proficient in both these areas at the same time, so I usually recommend diverse sources for each of these ministries. Deliverance and healing can strengthen your relationship with Christ, but it is your relationship with Christ that will fix your marriage, your addiction, and your problems.”

Once I go through deliverance will I need more deliverance?

Yes. Asking this question is like asking do I need to continue to pray or continue to read God’s Word. Of course, you do. The answer to this question really relies on the commitment of a believer to live a God centered life. Deliverance is a daily walk. If you are able to live a life that is sin free, never opening doors to oppression, then you would never need deliverance again. Sadly, that is not reality. We are created with a sinful nature, and we will stumble. Many times, deliverance will change a believers walk with Christ because they come to the realization that they must live “clean” to remain free of oppression. The person realizes that there are actual consequences to sin.

Breaking off oppression from small open doors is like killing an occasional bug that comes into a house. It is not a big deal, however; there will always be those who go back to their ungodly lifestyle. It is like pouring honey all over the kitchen floor and going away for a week. The house may become completely infested with ants and a huge problem to clean up. If you choose to walk the line with the world or continue to live an ungodly lifestyle, invariably, you will become “reinfested” because of ungodly choices.

Who do I call if I need more deliverance?

Let's answer this question with a few other questions. Who do you call when you need to read the Bible? Who do you call when you need to pray? Who do you call when you need to eat? No one! You do it yourself. Now there may be situations where you need help reading the Bible, praying, or even eating, but those things are usually our responsibility. At some point, we all learned how to read, how to pray, and even how to eat. You absolutely must learn to walk in deliverance and freedom. In Luke 10:19, we are given authority over all the power of the enemy. In Mark 16:17, the first sign of a new believer is that they will cast out demons. This is not a Spiritual gift. It is part of your Spiritual walk just like prayer and reading scripture. Do not let your walk with Christ be destroyed because of your lack of knowledge. There are now many resources available to learn how-to walk-in deliverance. Use the books, videos, and the Word to begin to educate yourself. I recommend Don Dickerman's book "*Keeping the Pigs Out*" for post deliverance training. Walking in deliverance is your responsibility and should be part of your daily walk.

Will 'Be Healed Now' help me remain free?

'Be Healed Now' is like a body shop that repairs wrecked cars. If you set up an appointment and bring in your damaged vehicle, I can help repair the damage through the power of Christ. When you leave the shop, it is your responsibility to take care of your vehicle. You would never call the body shop because you made a mistake and drove through a huge puddle covering your car with mud. You would clean the car yourself and be embarrassed that you made a dumb mistake by driving through the mud. That same person will call us after their initial deliverance because they became upset with someone and allowed a spirit of bitterness and unforgiveness back into their life. Please do not call us after your initial deliverance for issues that God has given you the authority to handle yourself. Forgive the person, renounce unforgiveness, and cast it out in Jesus' name.

Links to plenty resources are also available on their Website. They say: *"I consistently receive post deliverance calls from people who do not want to walk in self-deliverance. They want someone to constantly do deliverance for them. Do not be that person. Educate yourself and learn to make deliverance part of your daily walk. Use your friends and prayer partners for daily maintenance. If you do not have friends or prayer partners, I can recommend people and churches for counseling. I also have post deliverance pastors that may help in counseling, however; deliverance should become part of a believer's lifestyle."*

How much time is invested for a deliverance candidate to be set free?

On average I spend about 8 hours between phone calls, paperwork, emails, questions, preparation and the actual deliverance sessions.

What are your office hours?

My hours are 9-3 Monday to Friday. I normally do not take calls on Weekends or at night. You may email us, and I will usually contact you within 48 hours by phone, email, or text.

Is a deliverance session like you see in the movies?

No, our sessions are not like the movies. A deliverance session is a counseling and a prayer session. I try to do deliverance sessions in a relaxed and comfortable environment. We normally sit facing each other on couches or in recliners if possible. The more relaxed and comfortable the smoother the deliverance session flows. A deliverance session is not a ritual or a screaming session. It is not a power encounter but a truth encounter. It's not like in the movies. We cancel legal rights and command the demons to go in Jesus' name.

You cannot fight the spiritual with the physical. You destroy the oppression with the authority you have been given in the name of Jesus. Most of the time there are no manifestations other than the demons leaving through your breaths, burping, sneezing or coughing. If severe manifestations begin to take place, I command the demon to stop manifesting, or I will stop the deliverance session until the manifestation is under control. If a stubborn demon will not leave after I have broken their right to oppress, I do not scream at the demon for hours like you may see in the movies. A deliverance session should be an amazing and joyful event. Movie and tv exorcisms have been produced under demonic influence and are created to terrify people. Of course, a true deliverance session is nothing like what you see in the movies or on TV. They are produced by demons.

Who will be in my deliverance session?

Just like my own personal deliverances with deliverance ministers (I have had two), in attendance is the deliverance minister (me), the candidate (you) and Holy Spirit. Also present to assist are angels of the Lord. At times there will be one other minister if the situation warrants it.

What is the most common oppression?

There will always be a strongman or one that oversees a person's oppression. Everyone is different, however; fear is the dominate oppression in most people. This will usually include depression, anxiety, rejection, worthlessness, sorrow, etc. These will usually all fall under the kingdom of fear. A demon of destruction will almost always be on ministry people including pastors. It will try and destroy a person's relationships, finances, ministry, health, and their life. These demons are assigned to a person because of their calling. Lust will be there from generational sins, pornography, promiscuity, rape, and molestation. Abuse will be there from rape and molestation. Trauma will open doors to fear and anxiety. Addiction will often be passed down generationally. Physical problems from cancer and disease to breathing issues and bowel problems can be demonic in nature and many times generational. Oppression is very complex and is different in each candidate.
